READ ABOUT IT

- 1) Read John 13:12-17. Why do you think Jesus put such a high priority on setting the example of serving others? Why do you think Jesus focused on this lesson on his last night with his disciples?
- 2) Read 3 John 1:11. How do you know an action or word is good and not evil? As a group, consider this question until you feel you can clearly explain why God's way is "good" to someone who is not yet a Christian.
- 3) Read James 1:22, 1 John 2:3, Romans 2:13, and James 4:17. Why does the Bible put such an emphasis on "doing"? What is the "next right thing" that God wants you to do?

APPLY IT

We want to help one another to grow spiritually. One way we can do that is to help one another do the next right thing (James 4:17). Have one person in the group write down each member's next right action. If anyone needs help thinking of an action or completing one, take time to make a clear plan and intentionally support one another throughout the week.
